RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE J20 TO THE G20 SHERPAS

In order to contribute to the preparation process of the G20 Summit in Brazil, the coordination of the J20 – Summit of Heads of Supreme Courts and Constitutional Courts of the G20 – conveys the following recommendations to the G20 sherpas:

- It is important to maintain ongoing dialogue among the Judiciary branches of various countries, encouraging the exchange of ideas and sharing of initiatives. In an increasingly interconnected world through the international flow of people, goods, services, capital, and information, many challenges faced by courts are becoming more similar.
- The J20 meeting, held in Rio de Janeiro from May 12 to 14, 2024, selected three themes that affect most Constitutional Courts around the world to varying degrees: social inclusion and promotion of citizenship; climate litigation and sustainable development; and the use of technology to enhance the efficiency of the Judiciary.
- The Brazilian coordination of the J20 recommends continuing this exercise in future G20 presidencies.
